

RYMARZ ▪ ZDORT \ MARUTA

This wine comes from vines grown on land that has belonged to the Manso de Zúñiga family since 1260. It was produced from vines planted in 1874, just before the outbreak of the phylloxera epidemic that destroyed almost 90% of European vineyards. The vines survived the blight because the soil in the Rioja region is sandy, and today it is the oldest Tempranillo wine variety in the world.

The current heir, count Íñigo Manso de Zúñiga, personally manages the winery: he produces limited quantities of wine from only the best vintages, including 2011.

1 January 2023 marked the union of our law firms – Rymarz Zdort and Maruta Wachta. We are sharing this unique wine with you to celebrate this occasion.
